



I am directed to say that as a follow up of the first meeting of the Prime Minister's National Council on India's Nutrition Challenges, a meeting to discuss Bringing Strong Nutrition Focus in Sectoral Programmes was held by the Planning Commission on 05.01.2011. - i. Mainstream Nutrition in the training of PRIs - especially Women Panchayat members for malnutrition free Panchayats and earmarking certain wards to them.
 - ii. Support the development of innovative district models run by PRIs within the 200 high burden districts initiative.
 - iii. Share best practices to support the devolution of powers related to nutrition programmes - to PRIs in all States.
