**NOTICE**

Expression of Interest is sought for supporting the State Mahatma Gandhi NREGA Cell in the Panchayats & Rural Development Department, Government of West Bengal for providing technical support to the State for the purpose of monitoring quality of scheme implementation including detailed enquiries on the complaints against irregularities in programme implementation received from different sources.

A pool of State Quality Monitors will be enlisted with qualified and experienced retired engineers under the following terms and conditions.


1. The team of senior engineers will be earmarked for the following zones of the state as per the following table:

2. Their services will be used by the Department, as and when required. However, such services should be made available for a minimum of 7 days in a month for field-based activities. For field visit the department will pay fees @Rs.4000.00 per day of actual field visit. In addition, logistics will be arranged by the district where the field visit will be made. Any outstation travel will also be reimbursed by the Department.

3. Field visit reports are to be submitted to the Department (MGNREGA Cell) within 7 days from the date of assignment. If necessary, the department may seek further report and explanations from the concerned SQM.
4. Retired Senior Engineers with requisite experience are requested to send their CV with a forwarding letter indicating interest in the assignment and preference of the zone by 26 August 2019.

Once the applications are received, the applicants will be asked to attend an interaction session in the department for further action. Applications are to be addressed to the Secretary, Panchayat & Rural Development Department, Government of West Bengal.
