Sir,

As guidelines under No.5160/PN/O/I/4F/2010 dated 21.06.2010 relating to utilization of 3rd SFC recommend grant for PR/s lays priority among others on promotion of public health, prevention of common diseases and improvement of health care, I am directed to state as clarification that purchase of medicines out of 3rd SFC grant can be made by the Gram Panchayats for smooth running of part time G.P. dispensaries duly approved under budget head or NRHM, medicines can be purchased after identifying the specific needs and maintaining financial priority with due convergence with the existing health care facilities .

I am also directed to state that expenditure on account of the said purpose shall not exceed Rs.15,000/- per annum for Homoeopath and Rs.20,000/- per annum for Ayurvedic Dispensary per Gram Panchayat.
